09th November 2021 at Garvebhavi Palya Village, Bangalore -560068

"Beti Bachao Beti Padhao" is a government social scheme launched by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi in order to address the gender imbalance and discrimination against girl child in the Indian society. This scheme is regarding girl safety, protection and better education in the future without much load on the parents. As per the evaluation report of NITI Aayog, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme has been able to generate significant mass- mobilization to eliminate gender discrimination and valuing the girl child and the scheme has been able to develop many good practices and community-level initiatives. The awareness about the scheme was also found to be high.

In view of above government instruction We, Students and Faculties of The Oxford College of Engineering initiated program to create awareness among Garebhavi playa village people to benefits of, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP). Consistent efforts are made under BBBP at all levels to generate awareness about the rights of girl child through community engagement, stop sex selection at birth and encourage positive action to support their education growth and development. Convergent efforts are made in collaboration with other Ministries and stakeholders. The implementation of the Scheme is monitored by the task force under BBBP at District, State and National level.

The overall objective of the BBBP Scheme is to address the issue of decline in Child Sex Ratio and create an enabling environment for education of the girl child. Child Sex Ratio (Census by Registrar General of India) is a decadal process. Hence, an intermediary targets i.e. Sex Ratio at Birth have been set as a monitoring parameter for the progress of Scheme. SRB (as per Health Management Information System (HMIS) of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare) has shown an improving trend

The objective of the scheme is to address issues from declining Child Sex Ratio (CSR), women empowerment, removal of gender inequality to protecting a girl child. The scheme also tries to ensure education of the girl child and her participation in the society.





Figure 2: Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme awareness Program




Figure 5: Explanations about Usefulness of BBPP Program





The main highlights of the session were – various types of stress faced by teenagers, stress relaxation therapy and different stress management techniques. The session had lots of Games, Activities and Role plays

The life of a student can be a stressful one. Factors such as homework, social life, perceived parental pressure and never-ending workloads all generate stress. Extra-curricular activities help students build confidence, explore hobbies, and develop values such as teamwork and responsibility.

The ability to distinguish between choice and needs plays a vital role in the life of students. The session focused on techniques the students can use while taking decisions about their college life and career. This would help students focus not just on their curriculum but also on their extracurricular activities leading to a less stressful journey. Emphasis was laid on the stress is generated by oneself and it can be controlled by oneself. Building confidence was another foundation laid during this session via role play activities which helped remove the element of fear from the student's minds, the main prominence was focused on the motto "Fake it till you make it".






Details of the Program


Motivational Talk by Dr. Preeta S




