

Beti Bachao Beti Padhao is a government social scheme launched by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi in order to address the gender imbalance and discrimination against girl child in the Indian society. This scheme is regarding girl safety, protection and better education in the future without much load on the parents. As per the evaluation report of NITI Aayog, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme has been able to generate significant mass- mobilization to eliminate gender discrimination and valuing the girl child and the scheme has been able to develop many good practices and community-level initiatives. The awareness about the scheme was also found to be high.

In view of above government instruction We , Students and Faculties of **The Oxford College of Engineering** initiated program to create awareness among Garebhavi playa village people to benefits of , Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) .Consistent efforts are made under BBBP at all levels to generate awareness about the rights of girl child through community engagement, stop sex selection at birth and encourage positive action to support their education growth and development. Convergent efforts are made in collaboration with other Ministries and stakeholders. The implementation of the Scheme is monitored by the task force under BBBP at District, State and National level.

The overall objective of the BBBP Scheme is to address the issue of decline in Child Sex Ratio and create an enabling environment for education of the girl child. Child Sex Ratio (Census by Registrar General of India) is a decadal process. Hence, an intermediary targets i.e. Sex Ratio at Birth have been set as a monitoring parameter for the progress of Scheme. SRB (as per Health Management Information System (HMIS) of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare) has shown an improving trend

The objective of the scheme is to address issues from declining Child Sex Ratio (CSR), women empowerment, removal of gender inequality to protecting a girl child. The scheme also tries to ensure education of the girl child and her participation in the society.

Date: 11-05-2022 to 13-05-2022 Time: 10:00am - 4:00pm

The main aim of this campaign is to raise fundamental demands for the recognition and welfare of the domestic work, so that they can lead a dignified life.

This campaign is mainly taking place in four states Rajasthan, Maharastra, Karnataka and Delhi. In Karnataka, in Bangalore we have visited some of the localities like Tilak Nagar, J P Nagar, Nakalgudde, Bilekahalli, etc., speak to the domestic workers in that particular locality and make a note of the demands they are in need of and write those demands in a postal card and take these cards to Chief Minister and Labour Minister and bring into their notice about the condition of these workers.

The most common demands were:

- Domestic workers should be registered with the Labour board. Employer's registration to be mandatory.
- ii. The labour board should issue an identity card.
- iii. The comprehensive law for domestic workers should be made a reality.
- As per the act of 2008, all states should form a welfare board to provide for social protection and social security.
- Easy access for entitlements from the Central and State governments, for domestic workers, including migrant domestic workers.
- vi. ILO convention C-189 should be ratified.

These demands are signed by the domestic workers on the post cards.

On June 16th, it is recognized as 'National Domestic workers day'. This is the day on which these post cards will be being given to the Ministers and demand them for the welfare of these workers.

The MBA department of The Oxford College of Engineering conducted an outreach program on 24th May 2022, with a visit to the Mathrubhoomi, a non-profit organization registered under Karnataka Societies Act 1960. It is a residential Hostel for Boys promoting better education, Better Care and better future for boys. Children in this residential hostel have been handpicked from slum areas, children who have lost a parent and who are from slums, wandering around and not going to school.

There are 17 children at the residential hostel aged from 4 to 11 years. They reside at the hostel and attend the school at the government school at the main road. Stationary items comprising of ruled books, lead pencils, colour pencils, blue and red pens were purchased and distributed it to 17 children of Mathrubhoomi.




