The Oxford college of Engineering, Bangalore- Department of Computer Science and Engineering organised outreach activity on “Awareness about proper maintain of menstrual hygiene” on 2nd March 2024. Regarding to this program, Mrs. Chaitrashree S, who is the Assistant Professor of CSE Department of TOCE visited Vaddarapalya, Begur, Bengaluru.

Mrs. Chaitrashree S has taken part in the activity by giving simple explanation for biological and hormonal processes which most are unaware of due to lack of accurate information. She guided the women's to follow hygiene practices during menstruation to stay safe and healthy.

OBJECTIVE:

The “Awareness about proper maintain of menstrual hygiene” outreach program aims to achieve several key objectives like:

>**Prevention of Infections:** Proper menstrual hygiene practices aim to prevent infections such as urinary tract infections (UTIs), vaginal infections, and reproductive tract infections. Regular changing of menstrual hygiene products and maintaining cleanliness of genital areas help in reducing the risk of infections.

>**Promotion of Reproductive Health:** Good menstrual hygiene contributes to overall reproductive health. By using clean and appropriate menstrual products, women can avoid complications that may arise from unhygienic practices, such as pelvic inflammatory disease and cervical infections.

>**Reduction of Health Risks:** Improper menstrual hygiene can lead to various health risks, including skin irritation, rashes, and foul odors. Maintaining good menstrual hygiene reduces these risks and ensures comfort and confidence during menstruation.

>**Enhancement of Confidence and Dignity:** Adequate menstrual hygiene practices help in maintaining dignity and confidence among women and girls. Access to clean menstrual products and facilities for proper disposal of used products are essential for ensuring that menstruation does not hinder daily activities or lead to embarrassment.

>**Prevention of Social Stigma:** In many societies, menstruation is still surrounded by stigma and taboos. Proper menstrual hygiene education and practices can help dispel myths and misconceptions about menstruation, thereby reducing social stigma and discrimination against menstruating individuals.

Students gave simple explanation of how to remain hygiene during periods like using sanitary pads instead of cloth, changing it regularly. Also they explained about the causes of not remaining hygiene to the women's.

Prof. Chaitrashree S also taken part in the activity along with the students.

She concluded the session by providing gift pack containing sanitary pads to all the women's who was involved in the session.

20 students from CSE and 1 faculty were participated in the Outreach program.

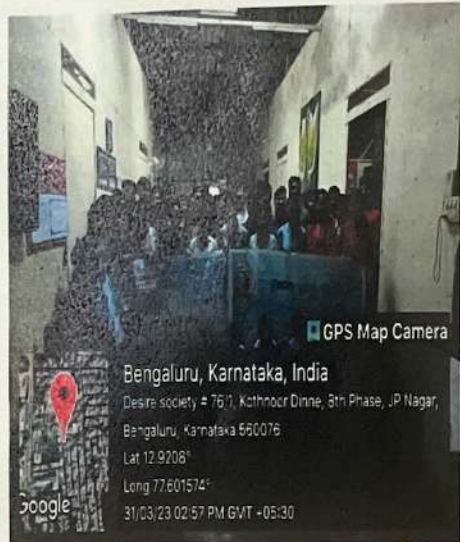
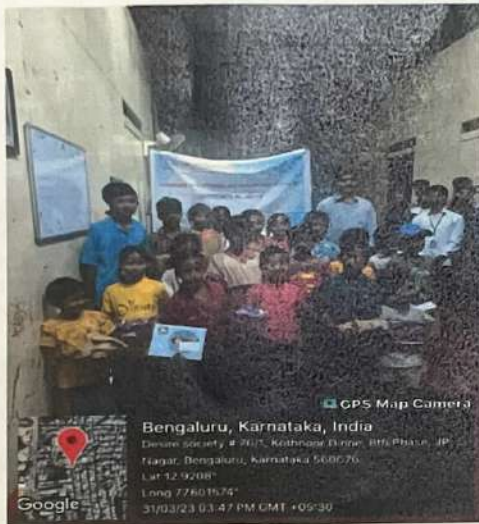
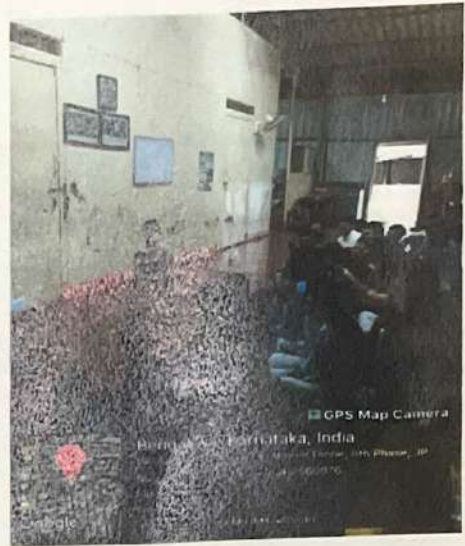
Students had a discussion with office members about the objectives of the

On 5th July 2024, the Department of Electrical & Electronics Engineering (EEE), in collaboration with the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit, organized an outreach activity titled “Digital Literacy Awareness Campaign.” The primary goal of the campaign was to educate the local community on the basics of digital literacy, including internet usage, digital devices, and online safety. In today’s technology-driven world, digital literacy has become a fundamental skill, and this initiative aimed

to equip participants with the knowledge and tools needed to navigate the digital landscape effectively.. The venue of the event was Hongasandra. At 2.30 p.m Students volunteers and faculty members of EEE gathered in the classroom N513 and then started to Hongasandra locality.. 40 students and 3 faculty members participated in this outreach activity.

Objective:

The core objectives of the outreach activity were:

To raise awareness about digital literacy and its importance in daily life.

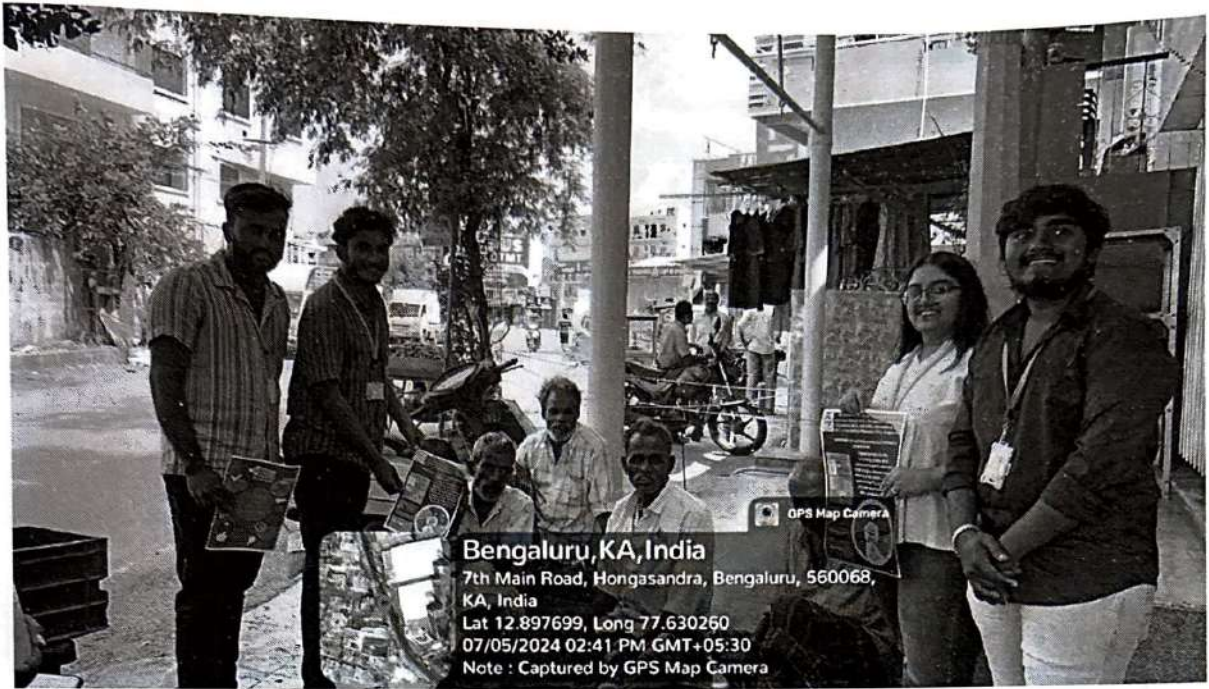
To educate participants on how to use digital devices such as smartphones, tablets, and computers.

To introduce the community to online platforms for banking, education, and communication.

To emphasize the importance of online safety and cybersecurity to protect personal data.

To empower participants, especially senior citizens and those from underprivileged backgrounds, to adopt digital technologies for a better quality of life.







The outreach activity provided an overview of common digital devices such as smartphones, tablets, and computers. Participants were introduced to basic operations, including how to turn on and navigate these devices, use mobile apps, and connect to the internet.

This session focused on explaining various online services, including e-banking, government services, social media, and educational platforms. The speakers demonstrated how to perform basic tasks like transferring money online, filling out government forms, and using social media to stay connected. A crucial part of the event, this session highlighted the importance of online safety. Participants were informed about protecting their personal data, avoiding online scams, and creating strong passwords. The discussion also covered cyber threats such as phishing and identity theft, and how to recognize and avoid them.

The local community responded with enthusiasm and gratitude for the campaign. Many participants, particularly senior citizens and those from economically weaker sections, expressed how the sessions helped them overcome their fear of digital devices and the internet. Several attendees shared that this was their first time learning how to use smartphones and online services like digital banking. They appreciated the hands-on approach and the patience shown by the volunteers. Overall, the community expressed their desire for more such initiatives to continue developing their digital skills.

The Digital Literacy Awareness Campaign successfully achieved its goals of raising digital awareness and providing practical skills to the participants. Some of the key outcomes were:

- People gained confidence in using digital devices and accessing online services.
- Got the awareness on learned how to perform basic online transactions.
- There was an increased awareness of cybersecurity threats and how to protect personal information online.

The outreach activity on "Digital Literacy Awareness Campaign" was a commendable initiative by the Department of Electrical & Electronics Engineering and the NSS Unit. The campaign empowered participants with essential digital skills, promoting digital inclusion and helping bridge the digital divide in the community. By equipping individuals with the knowledge to navigate the

digital world safely and efficiently, the event contributed to building a more digitally literate and inclusive society.

The primary objectives of the outreach activity were:

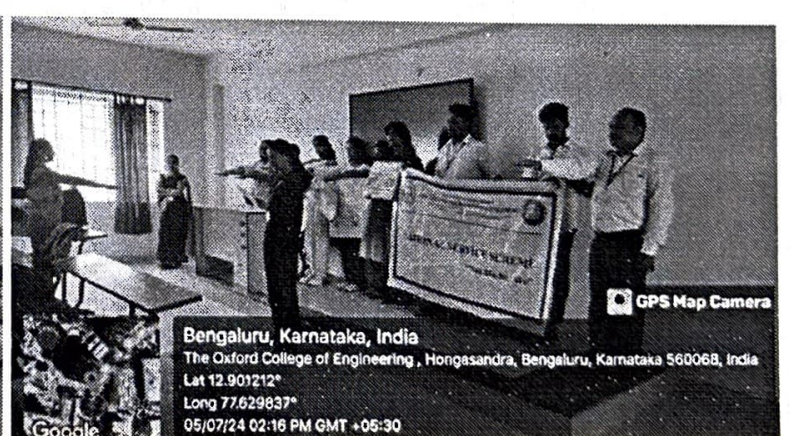
- To create awareness about the significance of gender equality and the need to protect and educate the girl child.

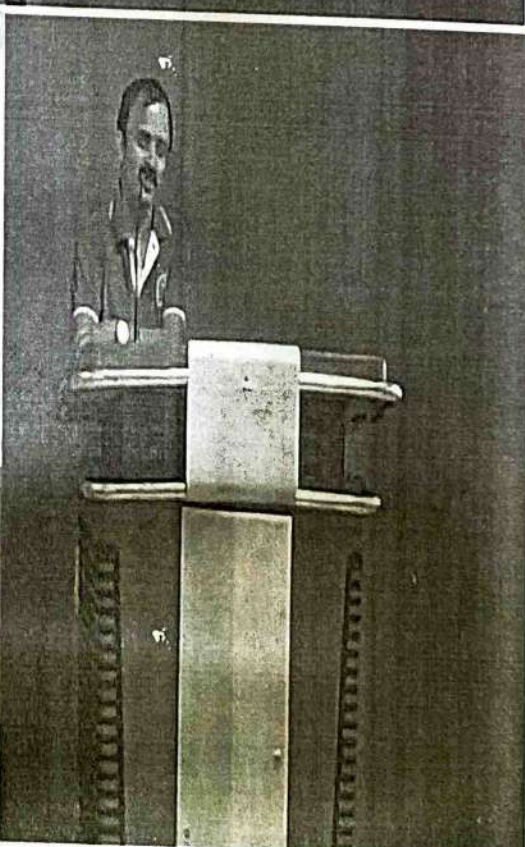


Figure 2: Inauguration & Speech by the Guest on Traffic Awareness

Social awareness on environment

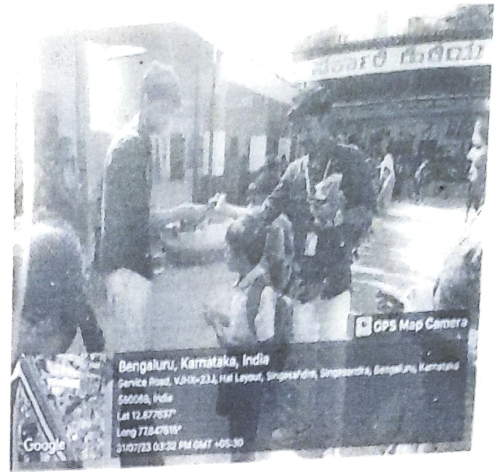

The Oxford college of Engineering, Bangalore- Department of Computer Science and Engineering organised outreach activity on “Awareness about proper maintain of menstrual hygiene” on 2nd March 2024. Regarding to this program, Mrs. Chaitrashree S, who is the Assistant Professor of CSE Department of TOCE visited Vaddarapalya, Begur, Bengaluru.

Mrs. Chaitrashree S has taken part in the activity by giving simple explanation for biological and hormonal processes which most are unaware of due to lack of accurate information. She guided the women's to follow hygiene practices during menstruation to stay safe and healthy.

OBJECTIVE:

The “Awareness about proper maintain of menstrual hygiene” outreach program aims to achieve several key objectives like:

>**Prevention of Infections:** Proper menstrual hygiene practices aim to prevent infections such as urinary tract infections (UTIs), vaginal infections, and reproductive tract infections. Regular changing of menstrual hygiene products and maintaining cleanliness of genital areas help in reducing the risk of infections.

>**Promotion of Reproductive Health:** Good menstrual hygiene contributes to overall reproductive health. By using clean and appropriate menstrual products, women can avoid complications that may arise from unhygienic practices, such as pelvic inflammatory disease and cervical infections.

>**Reduction of Health Risks:** Improper menstrual hygiene can lead to various health risks, including skin irritation, rashes, and foul odors. Maintaining good menstrual hygiene reduces these risks and ensures comfort and confidence during menstruation.

>**Enhancement of Confidence and Dignity:** Adequate menstrual hygiene practices help in maintaining dignity and confidence among women and girls. Access to clean menstrual products and facilities for proper disposal of used products are essential for ensuring that menstruation does not hinder daily activities or lead to embarrassment.

>**Prevention of Social Stigma:** In many societies, menstruation is still surrounded by stigma and taboos. Proper menstrual hygiene education and practices can help dispel myths and misconceptions about menstruation, thereby reducing social stigma and discrimination against menstruating individuals.

Students gave simple explanation of how to remain hygiene during periods like using sanitary pads instead of cloth, changing it regularly. Also they explained about the causes of not remaining hygiene to the women's.

Prof. Chaitrashree S also taken part in the activity along with the students.

She concluded the session by providing gift pack containing sanitary pads to all the women's who was involved in the session.

20 students from CSE and 1 faculty were participated in the Outreach program.
