Planning and Preparation



These stories showed us that there are many paths to success after graduation. They reminded us to keep trying, keep learning, and to stay true to ourselves along the way.

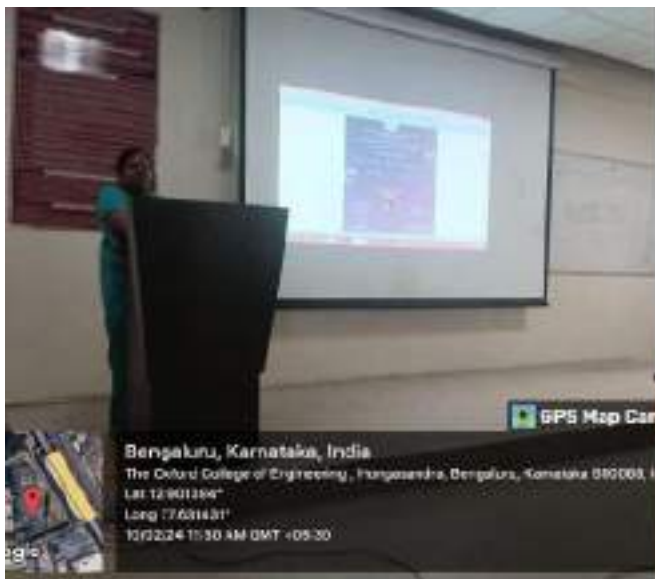
- **Vote of Thanks:**

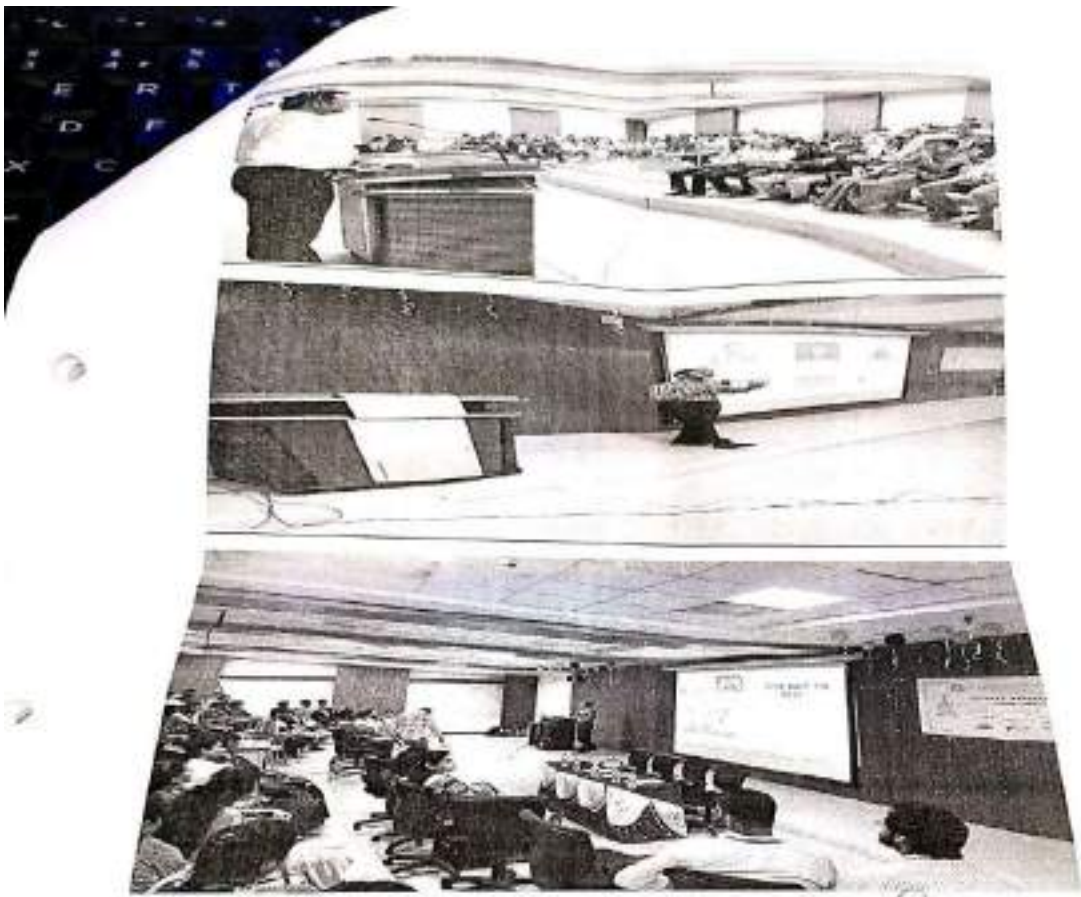

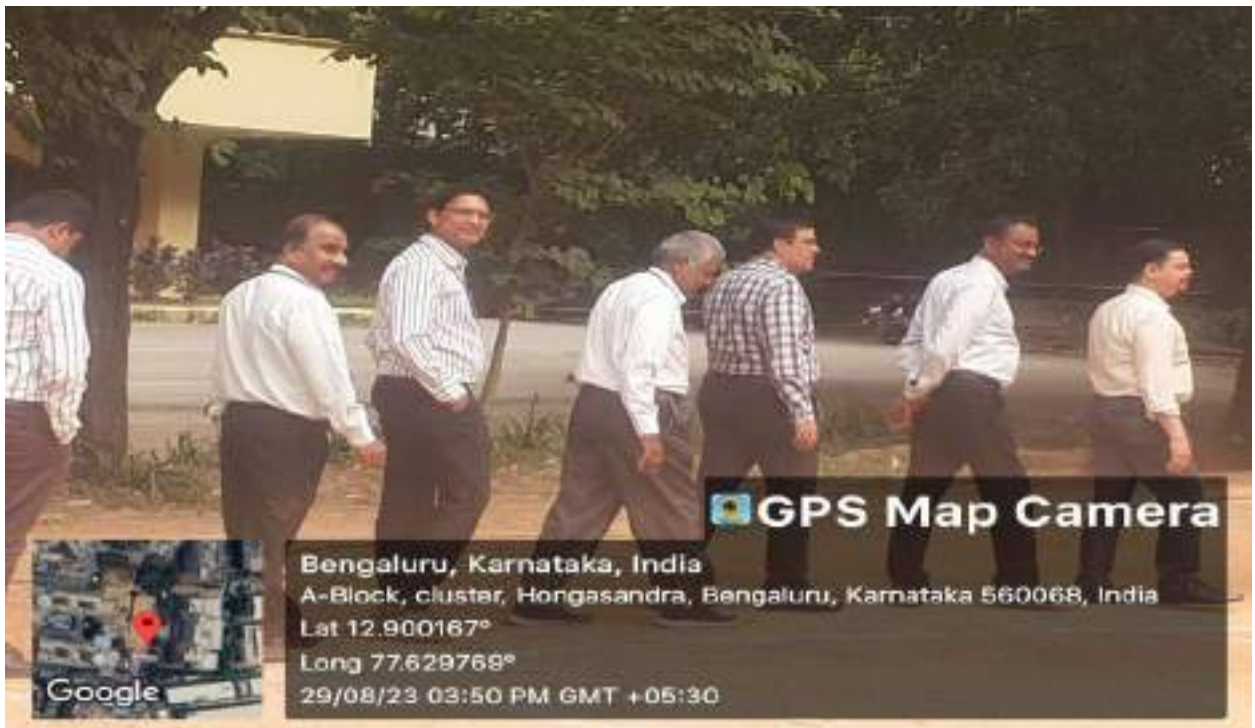


