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#### **ANNUAL REPORT ON ICC 2023-2024**

The Internal Complaints Committee held four meetings during the academic year 2023-2024 to maintain a safe and supportive environment for all students and to address any concern. The first meeting of the Internal complaints Committee, held on 4<sup>h</sup> August 2023 focused on providing an overview of internal complaints policies and guidelines, informing newly admitted students about UGC and AICTE regulations, reviewing past incidents, and planning awareness programs for incoming students. Key decisions included the implementation of awareness campaigns and establishing regular monitoring and anonymous reporting mechanisms. The Committee Members agreed to convene the next meeting in November. They decided that responsibilities should be assigned to each staff member to ensure active participation in maintaining a disciplined environment. The Cell members confirmed that no complaints had been reported. The Committee decided to display posters across various areas of the college to raise awareness. The meeting was then concluded by the Chairperson.

The second meeting of the Internal complaints Committee, held on 15<sup>th</sup>November 2023 focused on the participation of Committee at District-Level meetings, formed a comprehensive Internal complaints Committee with parents, and students. and confirmed no complaints of ragging had been reported. The chairperson informed committee members to instruct the students that they must submit an affidavit, along with a parent undertaking, in compliance with government regulations. Additionally, the college has an active Students' Counseling Cell and a mentoring system in place to provide guidance and support to students. The meeting was then concluded by the Chairperson.

The third meeting of the Internal complaints Committee, held on 5<sup>th</sup> February 2024, discussed the functioning of the Internal complaints committee Cell and identified key areas to ensure a safe environment. It was noted that, as per AICTE guidelines, the consequences are clearly outlined in the institution's prospectus and hostel manuals. Additionally, the committee proposed the establishment of a Mentoring Cell, consisting of senior faculty and student representatives, to proactively prevent misconduct within the institution and hostel premises. The Committee proposed creating a dedicated cell to encourage parent involvement in providing suggestions and addressing grievances. Additionally, the Committee emphasized the goal of achieving a zero complaint environment on campus through proactive measures and strict enforcement of policies and then meeting concluded by the Chairperson.

The fourth meeting of the Internal complaints Committee, held on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2024 intended that during Class-Committee meetings, the Principal, Heads of Departments, and Attendance In-Charges raised awareness about prevention and addressed related issues. The cell members confirmed that no complaints had been reported, and the Chairperson concluded the meeting on a positive note. The Committee stressed the need for regular monitoring and prompt resolution of any complaints. The Coordinators, periodically organizes awareness sessions and provides guidance to students on preventive measures. To date, no incidents have been reportedthen meeting concluded by the Chairperson.
