Research and Development Centre Abstract

The Oxford College of Engineering has continued to demonstrate significant progress in research productivity, quality, and innovation. While the total number of publications increased to 155 during 2023-2024, the quality and indexing of the publications reflect notable improvement. In 2024, 89 publications were indexed in Scopus, an increase from 78 in 2023. Google Scholar-indexed publications also increased to 37 in 2024. This shift signifies a greater focus on enhancing the reach and recognition of research work.

Additionally, the institution has sustained its momentum in securing research funding. In the academic year 2023-24, the college secured **Rs 41,20,196** from prominent funding agencies like KSCST, VGST, and SERB, reflecting the continued trust of funding bodies in the institution's research potential. Although slightly lower compared to Rs 45,63,000 in 2022-23, this achievement underscores the institution's ability to consistently attract significant financial support for high-impact projects.

In terms of intellectual property, The Oxford College of Engineering has demonstrated a strong performance in patent filings and grants. For the academic year 2023-24, the institution successfully filed **31 patents**, with a remarkable **10 granted**, and **18 patents published and 3**

filed. This marks a notable improvement in granted patents compared to the previous academic year 2022-23, where **3 patents were granted** and **24 patents were published**. The increase in granted patents highlights the quality and practical applicability of the research conducted.
