#### 1. Introduction

Graduate Aptitude Testin Engineering (GATE) is an examination conducted jointly by the Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore and the seven Indian Institutes of Technology (at Bombay, Delhi, Guwahati, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madrasand Roorkee) on behalf of the National Coordination Board (NCB) GATE, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India.

QualifyinginGATEisamandatoryrequirementforseekingadmissionand/orfinancialassistanceto: (i) Master's programs and direct Doctoral programs in Engineering/Technology/Architectureand (ii) Doctoral programs in relevant branches of Science, in the institutions supported by theMHRD and other Government agencies. MHRDscholarship/assistantship,theGATEqualificationismandatory.Further,many Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) have been using the GATE score in their recruitmentprocess.

## 2. AboutGATE

GraduateAptitudeTestinEngineering(GATE)isbasicallyanexaminationonthecomprehensiveunder standingofthecandidatesinvariousundergraduatesubjectsinEngineering/Technology/Architecture and post-graduate level subjects in Science. The GATE examination centres are spread in different cities acrossIndia, as well as, in six cities outside india. The examination would be purely a Computer BasedTest(CBT).

The GATE score would reflect the relative performance level of the candidate in a particular subject, which is quantified based on the several years of examination data. Note that the GATE score is valid for THREEYEARS from the date of announcement of the results.

#### Administration

GATEisadministeredjointlybytheIndianInstituteofScience(IISc),BangaloreandsevenIndianInstitut esofTechnology(namely,IITsatBombay,Delhi,Guwahati,Kanpur,Kharagpur,MadrasandRoorkee). TheGATECommittee,whichcomprisesofrepresentativesfromtheadministeringinstitutes, is the sole authority for regulating the examination and for declaring the results. Foradministrative purposes, the examination cities in India are segregated into eight zones. Theoperations related to GATE, in each of the eight zones, are managed by a Zonal GATE Office attheadministeringinstitute(IITorIISc).

Table 2.1 gives details of the zones and the corresponding administering institutes.

One of the administering institutes is designated as the **Organizing Institute** (OI), and it would be responsible for the end-to-endprocess, as well as, the overall coordination amongst the administering institutes for conducting the **GATE** Examination.

## Scholarship/AssistantshipforPostgraduatePrograms

To avail the financial assistance (scholarship/assistantship), the candidate must first secure theadmissiontoaprograminoneofthecentralgovernmentsupportedinstitutes, by approcedure that could vary from institute to institute. Depending upon the norms adopted by aspecific institute or department of the institute, a candidate may be admitted directly into a course based on: his/her performance in GATE only; or based on his/her performance in GATE and an admissiontest/interview conducted by the department to which he/she has applied and/or the candidate's academic record. In the test/interview based selection procedure, as per the MHRD guidelines, aminimum of 70% weight age will be given to the candidate's performance in test/interview and/or academic record. However, the admitting institutes could prescribe a minimum passing marks in the test/interview.

Candidates are advised to seek the complete details of the admission procedures and the availabilityofMHRDscholarship/assistantshipfromthecorrespondingadmittinginstitutions. Thecrite riaforpostgraduateadmissionwithscholarship/assistantshipcouldbedifferentfordifferentinstitutions. The management of the post-graduate scholarship/assistantship is also the responsibility of theadmitting institution. Similarly, reservation of the seats for different categories will be as per thepolicies and norms of the admitting institution and the Government of Indiarules.

Candidates are expected to appear in a paper appropriate to the discipline of their qualifying degree. However, candidates are free to choose anyone of the GATE papers as pertheir admission or employment plan, while keeping in mind the eligibility criteria for the institutions in which they wish to seek admission/employment.
